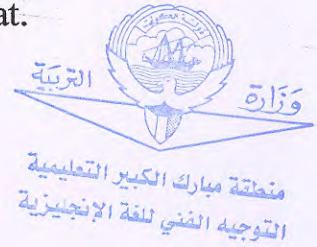

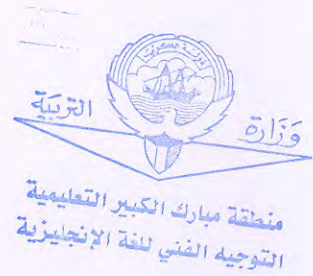

It costs them a lot of time and effort to reach their wanted destination. Most car drivers and pedestrians badly suffer from traffic jams plus the polluted air they breathe.

What makes matters worse is that most people go to work in the early morning and return home in the afternoon at about the same time. When this happens, traffic becomes miserable. This is called 'the rush hour'. Fortunately, some countries could overcome this problem by building underground systems that make the flow of traffic smooth and fast.
