Kevin Mitnick, the world's most known hacker broke into his first computer at the age of 16 when he hacked into a Digital Equipment Corp. by phoning the company and claiming to be the lead developer of a new product. Many of the jobs that Mitnick pulled depended on the ignorance of humans rather than the security software of the companies. He proved that a path can be made into a system without a computer or a modem. This "social engineering", was Mitnick's strength. Mitnick tries to warn corporations now that "We are getting to an era in life were humans are not smart enough to run the machines they created".

Mitnick's hacking career began because of his desperate need to find friends. As a child he had a trouble in meeting and keeping friends. Hacking gave him a sense of belonging in the world, **something** for him to do and do well. He began with little tricks such as stealing computer passwords and cracking into phone lines so he could make free phone calls. Mitnick didn't care for the bigger crimes of sending viruses or stealing money, he hacked more for the pure enjoyment. "It was about the adventure and the run after knowledge" Mitnick said.

Much of his work was done because he felt like he needed to prove himself. His tricks were sort of a look-what-I-did type of thing, letting everyone know of the power he possessed. Despite violating many of the privacy rights of different companies, he could be doing much worse things like sending computer destroying viruses. Some of the more severe things Mitnick has done include **switching** telephone records sending larger bills to people that he didn't like. US Government claims that he has caused up to \$5-10 million dollars in damage. He believes that he indeed has caused some trouble and has apologized for the mistakes he made.

After spending about five years in jail, Mitnick believes he is a different man. Ironically, he started his own company. His corporation <u>assissts</u> other businesses to stay out of the hackers' way. It is Mitnick's belief that the major fault of security is not with the actual computer-based security but is the "human factor". The knowledge that Mitnick possess on this field is incredible. He knows practically all the loops. But would you trust him with the security of your business?
